An offer of one year's free membership is available for juniors who have not previously been members of the Federation. Applications for this must be made by email to membership@englishchess.org.uk, stating name, address, and date of birth. Club membership and grading reference should also be given if known. The ECF membership year runs from the 1st September to the 31st of the following August.

Membership of the English Chess Federation at Silver, Gold or Platinum is a requirement to take part in Richmond's Club Championship, in Richmond Rapidplay and Blitz events and various team events.

RICHMOND JUNIOR CHESS CLUB HOME–CLUB AGREEMENT

RJCC is committed to the safety and welfare of the children in the Club. All our coaches have been DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) checked and have undergone appropriate Safeguarding training.

THE CLUB WILL:-

- Provide sets, boards, clocks and other material necessary for the playing of chess.
- Provide an atmosphere conducive to the playing and study of chess at a level appropriate to the age and ability of the Members.
- Oppose behaviour by anybody in the club that limits the ability of others to play and enjoy their chess, and seek to create an environment that is disciplined and supportive and in which individuals respect each other.
- Oppose and address bullying, harassment or abuse whether motivated racially or in any other way.
- Contact parents with regard to any problems concerning their children's behaviour or attitude.
- Be available at all times to speak to parents/carers with regard to their children's progress and ability at chess, and all other matters concerning their club membership.
- Maintain a Safeguarding Policy and appoint Safeguarding Officers. The Safeguarding policy and contact details of the Safeguarding Officers will be available on the Club website.
- During club times mobile phone use by coaches/parents present in rooms is prohibited except for the purposes of the Club Organiser calling a parent. If coaches need to make personal calls they will do so outside of the classrooms.
- CLUB photos for website - these will be taken ONLY on a digital camera (not mobile phones) as agreed with parents. We will inform parents of any general photos taken for our club website.

AS A PARENT/CARER I WILL:-

- Guarantee that my child is aware of the importance of a high standard of behaviour and the need to respect other people, and the club premises and equipment.
- Encourage my child by providing the opportunity to play and study chess regularly, to compete in tournaments and to represent the club in team competitions if selected.
- Support the club's disciplinary requirements as a necessary backdrop to the successful teaching of chess in a club environment.
- Accept reasonable sanctions and disciplinary measures taken by the club in the event of a misdemeanour involving my child.
