RJCC provides online chess classes using the Zoom video-conferencing platform. RJCC configures Zoom to provide a safe, child-friendly environment, consistent with principles of safeguarding, online security, privacy and data protection. Access to our Zoom classrooms requires login to a confirmed Zoom account (a free account is sufficient) using a Meeting Id and Password provided by RJCC.
